The Tribunal is scheduled to sit tomorrow afternoon (29.07.08) to hear two applications for licensing.

It is also hoped that a long-outstanding application by one Mr. Sohan Singh would eventually be resolved.

The Copyright Tribunal also looks forward to hearing a new application made by the Fiji Performing Right Association (FPRA) in association with the Australasian Performing Right Association Ltd. (APRA) and Fiji Television Limited (Fiji TV) at 3.00pm today (28.07.08).
